# *Preface*

This book is a result of years of classroom research to find the words that all good readers know.

It is a fact that most of us speak about 30,000 words per day and approximately 70 percent of these words consist of less than 1,000 different words. It is now possible for your child to know—out of more than 500,000 words in the English language—the small body of words which are used by the community, the authors of textbooks, and by the local newspapers.

Through testing of beginning seventh grade students, who were good readers, it was discovered that all the good readers knew at least 5,000 different words. In examining the textbooks use in elementary schools, it was also discovered that these same words are used better than 90 percent of the time. By using textbooks and resource materials, the words have been grouped into lists according to grade levels (1-6).

You have a chance to test your child's reading capability through these word lists. By helping your child learn these 5,000 words, you can not only increase his or her ability to read; but also to learn. It has been said that if you can read, you can learn anything. Math, science, history, geography and everyday life depends upon a student being able to read the material.

This book gives you a guide to the most common words that every good reader knows. Included are some hints to help make this learning a fun and exciting experience. But, your imagination is the only limitation of new ways to teach the words. Begin now and give your child the added confidence and edge on learning for the rest of his or her life.

# *Instructions to Parents*

There are two basic reason why children do not learn to read in the public schools:

1. Most teachers do not have the time or the patience to review the same words over and over with the child until those words are learned.
2. The public schools do not make available to the parents selected grade level word lists so that they will know which words their child should learn.

By using the selected grade level word list in *Words Every Good Reader Knows* you can go over the words as many times as necessary for the child to learn them. Just select a word list by the grade level. See and say the words to your child as you point to the particular words. Have the child see and say them back to you. You may want to use a “flash card” system. Daily work sessions are more beneficial than weekend marathons.

Do not be discouraged if the child has to review certain words several times. In a lifetime of reading a child will go over them thousands of times. You can be sure you child will learn to read if you take the time to help the child learn the words. The rewards will be immeasurable as your child becomes and outstanding reader.
